The PUMP for Nursing Mothers Act (S. 1658/H.R. 3110) was signed into law on December 29, 2022!

This legislation expands on the protections in the 2010 Break Time for Nursing Mothers law, making breastfeeding more accessible for working mothers across the nation.

The Pregnant Workers Fairness Act (PWFA) was also passed in December. This Act provides essential protections and accommodations for pregnant employees. Both pieces of legislation were a part of the omnibus spending bill.
